Secondary Chapter Membership

Currently, NACE National processes a fee for a secondary chapter and the National Board believes a policy change will deepens our member value. In the next few weeks, the secondary chapter policy will be as follows:

Professional, Nonprofit, Legacy, Young Professional, Student and Retired Members Members will be able to select ONE secondary chapter at no charge.

Corporate Members

Members in the Corporate Member packages may select up to THREE additional chapters at no charge.

This new membership feature will be available for existing members during their next renewal and to new members when they join.

NACE National has been using GlueUp since 2022 while working with the vendor to get it ready for use by our chapters. We are excited to announce that we will begin working with chapters on migration to GlueUp starting in Q1.
