



Student Member of the Year

The NACE Student Member of the Year award recognizes student members whose chapter participation, contributions, and involvement have paved the way for fellow and future students, as well as increased the chapter's involvement in the academic community.

Requirement:

- Submit a letter of recommendation (500 words maximum) from a member of the Chapter's Executive Committee.

Section 1: Elements Statement - 60 points total

- Describe the nominee's overall participation, contributions, involvement with NACE, and why they should receive this award. *30 points, 750 words maximum*
- Provide a testimonial from the nominee describing how NACE has personally and professionally impacted their life. *30 points, 750 words maximum*

Section 2: Supporting Material - 25 points, 1,000 words maximum

- Describe the nominee's participation in their student and/or professional chapter, including offices held, overall participation, Evolve or Experience conferences attended, contributions and involvement in the chapter.

Section 3: Collateral Material – 15 points total

- Upload the letter of recommendation from a member of the Chapter's Executive Committee (required).
- Upload a list of honors or awards the nominee has received, activities, volunteer experience, and school clubs. *10 points*
- Provide two pieces of information supporting the nominee's actions (for example, letters of recommendation from faculty member or academic advisor, photos, public press coverage including NACE newsletters). *5 points*
